1726/7	7 Mar	Elizabeth, infant dtr of John Cassbel was buried
1727	26 Mar	John Cassbell, "a poor shoemaker" was buried (John the master cordwainer of 1718?)
1731/2	9 Mar	Anne Cassbel, widow was buried
1735	7 Oct	William Cassbell & Elizabeth Titmarsh widow, both OTP were married by Banns
1736	10 Jul	Apprentice duty paid by "Will Casbill of Mildred in Cambridge Cordwr." for "John Casbill or Orwell" 16/24 June last, (for term) 4 yrs & 9 months
1736	12 Sep	Mary Cassbel, an Appentice [sic], the daughter of John and Anne Cassbel both deceased was Baptized September the 12th also
1741	23 Oct	William Casbell was bury.d (was he the cordwainer?)
1742/3	18 Jan	John Casborn of Meldreth and Anne Chamerlain OTP were married by Banns
1743	11 Dec	Thomas Son of John & Ann Casbel was Baptiz'd
1746/7	9 Jan	James son of John & AnnCasbell was baptized
1748	28 Oct	Thomas Sparks Widower & Elizabeth Casbull Widow by Banns (widow of William, d. 1741)
1748	6 Nov	James son of John & Anne Casbull (was baptized) (probably moved to Therfield; cordwainer)
1750/1	10 Mar	Mary Daughter of John & Ann Casbal, baptized - unknown after that
1754	23 Sep	Anna daug.r of John & Ann Casburn (buried 23 May 1768)
1756	16 Jul	William Carsburn was buried (bp. 1695 Orwell or b. 1702/3, bp. 1707 Meldreth?)
1768	23 May	Anne dtr of John/Anne buried (see bp. 1754)
1769	25 Oct	(Melbourn) Thomas Casbon (bp. 1743) & Jane Wilson (both OTP) married by Banns
1770	18 Feb	Anne Casbull wife of John Casbill, buried
1770	23 Jun	Anne Casbull Daughter of Thos. and Jane Casbull, baptized
1770	13 Oct	Anne Casbull Daughter of Thos. and Jane Casbull, buried
1772	19 Jul	James Casbull Son of Thomas and Jane Casbull, baptized
1773	11 Jul	Isaac Casbull Son of Thomas and Jane Casbull, baptized
1775	28 May	Thomas son of Thomas & Jane Casbul, baptized
1776	4 Feb	John son of Thomas & Jane Casbul, baptized (buried 29 Oct 1777)
1777	29 Oct	John Casborn son of Thos. & Jane, buried

1778	7 Jun	John, son of Thomas & Jane Casbon (buried - no baptism recorded)
1779	3 Oct	John son of Thomas & Jane Casborne, baptized
1781	29 Oct	William Rogers of the Parish of Chesterton Batchelor & Lydia Casbon OTP Spinster (married) (no baptism recorded; year of birth is estimated as 1761 from age 58 when she died 1819)
1793	16 Oct	(Great Eversden) James Casbon (bp. 1772) & Ann Ward both of this Parish were married (Bishop's Transcripts)
1794	2 Feb	Mary Casborn, 26, buried (b. apt 1768 – parents? Age given in Bishop's Transcripts, not Parish Register)
1794	9 Mar	Ruth daughter of James & Ann Casbon, baptized
1795	18 Feb	Ann wife of James Casborn, buried
1796	4 Jan	John Casborn, Parish Clerk, age 75 buried
1796	23 Nov	James Casbon (bp. 1772), widower, & Mary Howse, single woman, both OTP (married)
1798	20 May	Mary Daughter of James & Mary Casbon, baptized
1800	26 Jan	Nancy Daughter of James & Mary Casbon, baptized
1800	15 Oct	(Bassingbourn) Isaac Casbill of Meldreth (bp. 1772), & Susannah Howes OTP (married by Banns)
1802	29 Dec	John Casbon single man (bp. 1779), & Martha Wagstaff, single woman, both OTP (married by Banns)
1803	27 Nov	(Royston) Jane Casbon, daughter of John (bp. 1779) & Martha, baptized
1803	25 Dec	(born 3 Nov) Thomas, son of Isaac & Susanna Casbon, baptized
1805	25 Dec	(Royston) William Casburn, son of John & Martha, baptized
1806	28 Sep	(born 7 Sep) James, Son of James & Mary Casbon, baptized
1806	28 Sep	(born 23 Aug) William, Son of Isaac & Susannah Casbon, baptized
1808	9 Oct	(Whaddon) Edith, daughter of John (bp. 1779) & Martha, baptized
1811		Joseph Casbon, son of Isaac & Susannah born (estimated year based age at death)
1813		James Casbon, son of Isaac & Susannah born (estimated year based on censuses, etc.)
1813	3 Dec	John Casball, age 34, buried (bp. 3 Oct 1779)
1815	24 Jul	Samuel Barnes & Martha [Wagstaff] Casbon (widow of John, bp. 1779) married
1817	12 Jun	Wm Wood & Mary Casbon (daughter of James & Mary, bp. 1798) OTP married
1820	25 Jan	James Casbourn (bp. 1772), copyhold allotment 1 acre, 3 rood, 29 perch, Whitecroft Rd, Sheene manor, heriotable (1820 Inclosure Award)
1822	18 Oct	Thomas Casbon (bp. 1803) imprisoned on hulk <i>Leviathan</i> x 7 yrs
1823	19 Jul	John Prime of St. Benedict & Ann Casbon (presumably Nancy, daughter of James & Mary, bp. 26 Jan 1800) OTP married
1825	13 Sep	Isaac Casbourn (bp. 1773) age 52 buried
1827	15 Dec	(Steeple Morden) James Casbon (bp. 1806) of Meldreth & Ann Hitch OTP married
1828	7 Dec	(Melbourn Independant) [Alfred] Hitch Casbon, son of James & Ann (Hitch) (baptized; baptized at Holy Trinity Meldreth 25 Oct 1851)
1829	13 Feb	Nehehmiah Sell of Bassingbourn & Edith Casbourne (daughter of John & Martha bp. 9 Oct 1808 Whaddon) OTP married
1829	14 Mar	(Melbourn) Wm Casbon (bp. 1806) OTP & Mary Cooper Spinster of Meldreth married
1830	9 Oct	(Melbourn) Thomas Casbon (bp. 1803) & Emma Scruby, both OTP, married
1831	22 Oct	William Casbourn Bachelor (bp. 1805 at Royston) & Ann Clark Spinster OTP married
1831	22 Nov	Jane Casbourn Widow (of Thomas, bp. 1743), Chiswick End, age 90, buried
1832	3 Mar	Elizabeth Casbourn, daughter of William & Mary, baptized
1833	10 Mar	James Carsbon (bp. 1772), age 61, buried
1833	4 Oct	Ann Carsbourn (wife of James, bp. 1806), age 31, buried
1833	13 Oct	(born 7 Jan) Mary Anne Casbon, daughter of Thomas & Emma, baptized

1834		James Casbon listed in Jurors book for Cambridge County, Meldreth; tradesman, copyhold owner
1834	22 Aug	(Westminster, St. Martin in the Fields), James Casbon (bp. 1806) & Susanna Hayden Sanders, both OTP, married
1835	29 Mar	Edith Cusburn, daughter of William & Ann, baptized
1835	25 Jul	James Casbon (b. abt 1813) & Elizabeth Waller, both OTP, married by Banns
1835	28 Jul	Mary Carsbon (wife of Wm, bp. 1806, age 31, buried)
1835	17 Oct	(Royston) Joseph Casbon (b. abt. 1811) of Melbourn & Lydia Burgess OTP, married
1836	7 Feb	William Casburn, son of William & Elizabeth, baptized (one of the parents' names is incorrect; they are probably William, bp. 1806, & Mary, but could be James, b. abt. 1813, & Elizabeth)
1836	1 Jul	Sell Carsbon, son of Thomas & Emma, baptized (buried 24 Jul 1836, age 11 months)
1837	27 Jan	Mary Casburn (widow of James, bp. 1772?), age 75, buried
1837	6 Aug	Sell Casbon, son of Thomas & Emma, baptized
1837	8 Oct	Sarah Casburn, daughter of James & Elizabeth, baptized
1840	17 Aug	Susan Casbon (widow of Isaac, bp. 1773), age 68, buried
1840	29 Nov	Jane Casbon, daughter of William (bp. 1805) & Ann, baptized
1840	20 Dec	Lydia Casbon, daughter of James & Elizabeth, baptized
1840	20 Dec	Thomas Charles Casbon, son of Thomas & Emma, baptized
1841	19 Dec	Mary Casbon, daughter of James & Elizabeth, baptized
1843	16 Jul	John Casbon, son of William (bp. 1805) & Ann, baptized
1844	26 May	Jesse Casbon, son of Thomas & Emma, baptized

1847	25 Jul	Reuben Casbon, son of William (bp. 1805) & Ann, baptized
1848	6 Jun	Hannah Casbon (daughter of Joseph & Lydia), age 5, buried (no baptism recorded)
1849	27 May	John Casbon, son of James & Elizabeth, baptized
1850	29 Mar	Susannah Casbon (wife of James bp. 1806), age 44, buried
1850	15 Aug	Harriet Anne Casbon (daughter of Joseph & Lydia), age 11, buried (no baptism recorded)
1851	11 Jun	Lydia Casbourn (widow of Joseph, b. abt 1811), age 35, buried
1851	25 Oct	Alfred Hitch Casbon (adult baptism, see 7 Dec 1828)
1852	15 Feb	Samuel Clark Casbon, son of William & Anne (baptized, b. 9 Jul 1851)
1852	9 Apr	Emma Casbon (daughter of Joseph, b. abt 1811 & Lydia, both deceased), age 7, buried
1852	13 Aug	Emma Casbon, daughter of James & Elizabeth, baptized (born abt. Nov 1851)
1852	16 Aug	Elizabeth Casbon (wife of James, b. abt 1813), age 36, died
1853	8 Nov	Emma Casbon (daughter of James, b. abt 1813 & Elizabeth, deceased), age 2, buried
1855	26 Aug	Martha Casbon, daughter of William & Anne, baptized
1855	10 Nov	William Casbon (son of William, bp. 1806, & Mary) & Sarah West, married
1856		William Casbon (bp. 1806) & Martha Stone married (registered in Royston)
1860	13 Oct	William Catley of Melbourn & Edith Casbon (dtr of William, bp. 1805, & Ann) OTP married
1863	24 Jan	John Casban (son of William & Ann) & Ann Barnes both OTP married
1864	26 Apr	Ann Casbon (wife of John, previous entry), age 23, buried
1864	5 Jun	Eliza Ann Casbon, daughter of John & Ann (previous entry), baptized

1869	3 Oct	Ann Casbon (wife of William, bp. 1805), age 59, buried
1872	2 Nov	(Melbourn) Samuel Casbon (son of William & Ann) of Meldreth & Lydia Harrup OTP married
1875	7 Oct	William Casbon (probably the son of Isaac & Susannah, bp. 1806), age 69, buried
1877	3 May	William Casbon (age is probably incorrect; probably son of John & Martha, bp. 1805), age 77, died
1882	14 Dec	(Melbourn) Martha Casbon (widow of William, bp. 1806), age 76, buried
1896	7 Mar	William Casbon (son of William & Mary, bp. 1806), age 61, died (suicide)
1905	27 Dec	Sarah Casbon, age 81 ("Sarah of Hitchin" widow of William, previous entry), buried at Meldreth
1910		(1910 Valuation) item 1068, House buildings & orchard on Whitecroft Rd., occupied by Sam Pepper, owned by "Casbon, Sarah Exors of"
1910		(1910 Valuation) item 1194, Cottage, etc. on Whitecroft Rd., occupied by Sam Pepper, owned by "Casbon, Sarah Exors W Casbon House of Lords"
1939		Martha Casbon, b. 14 Mar 1855, living at Meldreth High St. (1939 Register) (buried Melbourn 19 Jan 1847)
